

Streetball (3X3 Basketball) Rules & Regulations of the European Maccabi Youth Games London 2024

1. Organisation

- a. The Streetball Committee of the European Maccabi Youth Games European Maccabi Youth Games will be responsible for the Streetball Competitions of the European Maccabi Youth Games.
- b. The Streetball Competitions will be conducted according to the international Basketball Rules and Regulations (F.I.B.A.), the English text will be binding.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant/Accreditation Card, issued by the Organising Committee of the European Maccabi Youth Games European Maccabi Youth Games and is registered for the Streetball competitions.
- d. Each team must bring two sets of numbered game shirts in different colors to each game.

2. Venues & Times

- a. The Streetball Committee of the European Maccabi Youth Games European Maccabi Youth Games will determine the venues and times of the Streetball competitions and the teams will be notified accordingly.
- b. The Streetball Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions, these decisions will be final.

3. Teams

- a. Each participating country may enter two team for the Junior Youth competition and two team for the Juniors Male competition and two team for the Female Youth competition.
- b. Each team may consist of up to four (4) players, approved by the Streetball Committee.
- c. Athletes in the Youth competition have to be born between January 1st 2006 and December 31st 2007.
- d. Athletes in the Juniors competition have to be born between January 1st 2008 and December 31st 2009.
- e. .

4. System of Competition

- a. Events
 - i. Competitions will be held for:
 1. Juniors Male
 2. Youth Male
 3. Youth Female
 - ii. The competitions will be conducted according to F.I.B.A. regulations and according to the number of entries.
- b. SYSTEM A – participation up to 6 teams;
 - i. The competitions will be played on a league basis of a single round-robin.

- ii. The winner of each game will be awarded two points, the loser one point. For a technical loss no points will be awarded.
- iii. In the event of two teams obtaining the same number of points, the team winning the game between them will take the better place.
- iv. In the event of more than two teams having the same number of points, classification will be made according to the number of league points gained in the games between them, i.e., a team which gains the higher number of points in the above-mentioned games will take the higher place, and so on.
- v. In the event that after the above mentioned, equality still exists between teams' classification will be made according to the score differences of the above teams (credit amount of points scored less debit amount of points scored).
- vi. In the event that equality still persists, classification will be made according to the proportion scores of the above teams (credit amount of scores divided by debit amount of points scored).
- vii. In the event that equality still persists, classification will be decided by a draw.
- viii. The first two teams in the league will compete for the title: "European Maccabi Youth Games Champion".
- ix. The teams in places 3 and 4 in the league will compete for the third place.
- x. The rest of the teams will be placed according to their league order.
- c. **SYSTEM B** – if the number of teams will be 7-10;
 - i. The teams will be divided into 2 groups at the draw.
 - ii. The teams from same country will compete in different group, if it is possible.
 - iii. In the event that after the draw, one or more teams will not appear and a situation arises whereby a group is short of two teams, the team drawn last will be moved from one group to another.
 - iv. The competitions will be played on a league basis of a single round-robin in Group A and Group B.
 - v. The Semi-Finals will be played based on the "Cross" system, i.e., the team placed first in Group A will play against the team placed second in Group B and the team placed second in Group A will play against the team placed first in Group B.
 - vi. The two winning teams of the Semi-Finals will play for the 1st and 2nd places, and the two losing teams in the Semi-Finals will play for the 3rd and 4th places.

5. Ball Specifications and Equipment

- a. The games will be played with F.I.B.A. approved official balls, with ball size 6.
- b. The Streetball Committee is authorized to change the brand name of the ball, if necessary. These decisions will be final.

6. Draw

- a. The draw will be a public draw before the opening of the European Maccabi Youth Games.

7. Officiating

- a. The Streetball Committee will select a Referees Committee, which in turn will appoint the referees of the competition.

8. General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete European Maccabi Youth Games Regulations, and must be read along with the instructions found in “General Rules&Regulations”.
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the “General Rules&Regulations”, the regulations written here will apply and be binding.
